### **New Bair Museum Opens June 8**

The new Charles M. Bair Family Museum and the agricultural displays and Museum Shop located in the barn will be open on Wednesday, June 8<sup>th</sup> at 10am. The Bair Home will not be available for tours however; visitors will receive a voucher to tour the home at a later date.

Director and Chief Curator Elizabeth Guheen and the staff moved most of the pieces from the Bair Home Dining Room into the Temporary Gallery into the new art museum. Some of the finest antiques, both furniture and silver, were in the Dining Room, so visitors can view those items in the bright light of the gallery space.

Road closures and the flooding waters of the Musselshell River in Meagher and Golden Valley counties prompted museum officials to postpone the opening originally scheduled for Memorial Day weekend. Thankfully, the Bair collection of valuable western artworks, priceless Indian artifacts, and American and European paintings recently installed are safely housed in the new 7,300 square foot state-of-the art, secured new museum.

**When to go:** The Charles M. Bair Family Museum will be open through Labor Day - 7 Days a Week, 10am to 5pm. The Museum will remain open through October from Wednesday to Sunday only. The extended fall hours allow for school tours, as well as the general public.

**Costs:** Ticket price \$5 for adult, \$3 for seniors, \$2 students.

**Location:** Bair Family Museum is located at 2751 Montana Hwy 294 in Martinsdale, Montana, a small community between White Sulphur Springs and Harlowton.
